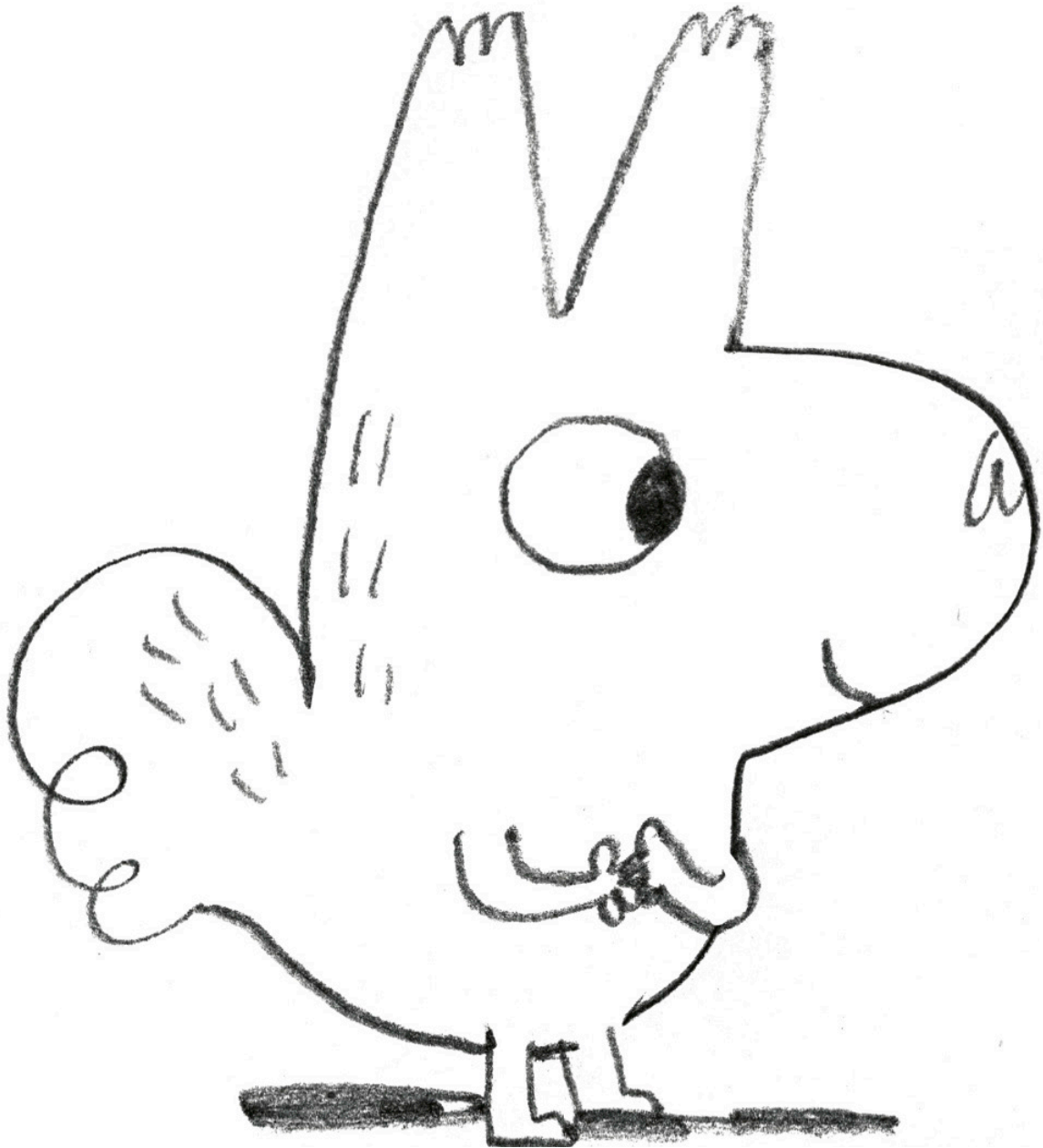
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Color Squirrel In!

What color would you make Squirrel? Add in any details you want to bring them to life!



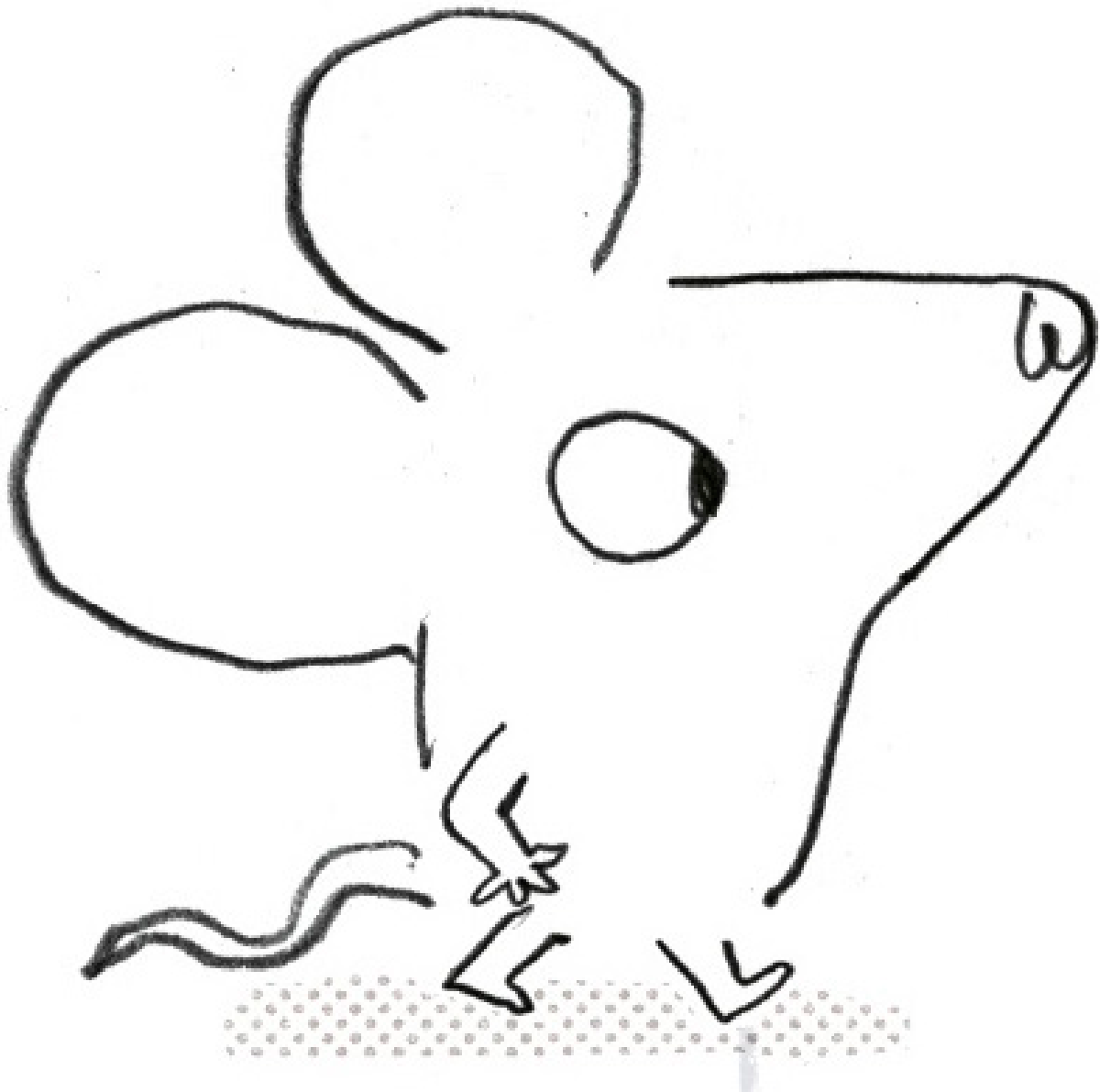
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Color Mouse In!

You can write your answer in the box, or even draw them using the item.

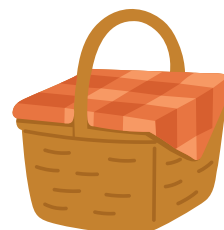

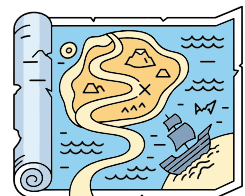

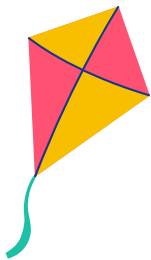

Design and color the funkiest new hat for Squirrel that you can imagine! Will it have feathers? Sparkles? It can be anything you want!



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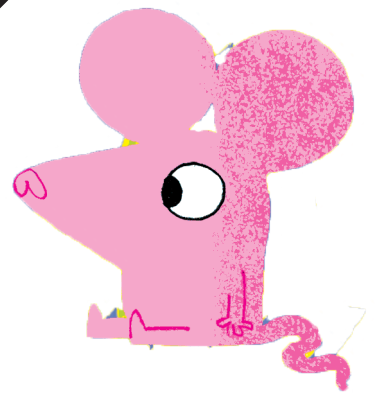
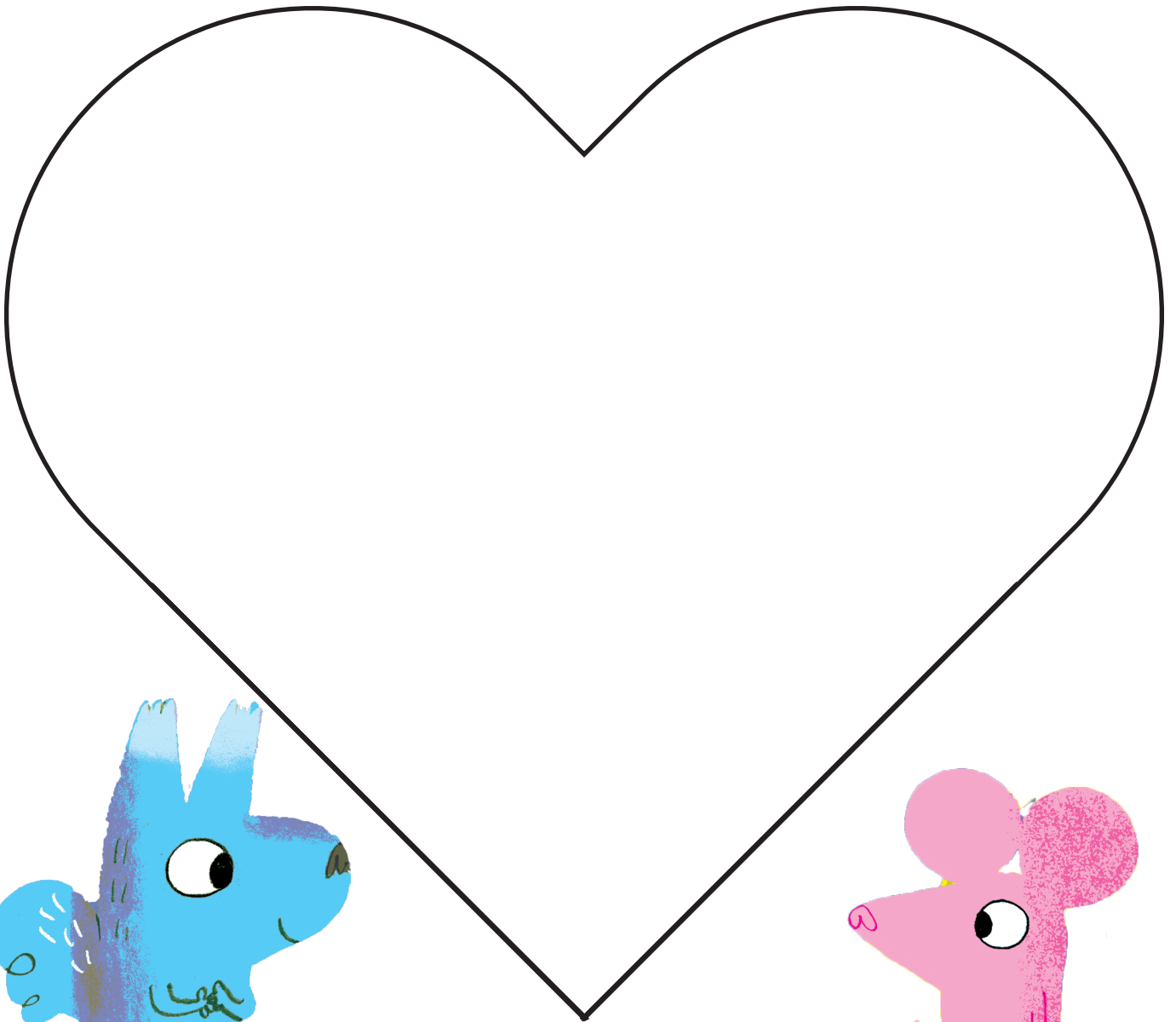




Heart of Happiness

Think about what makes a great friend.

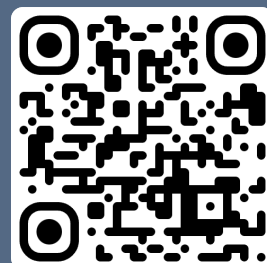
Now it's time to draw your own imaginary friend—someone who represents the PERFECT friend. Then write down the qualities that make them special.

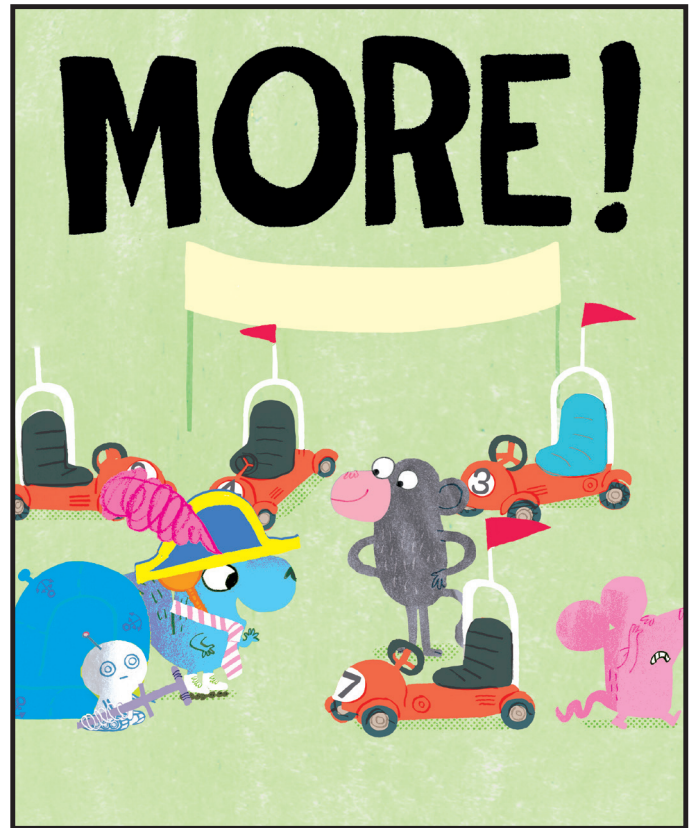
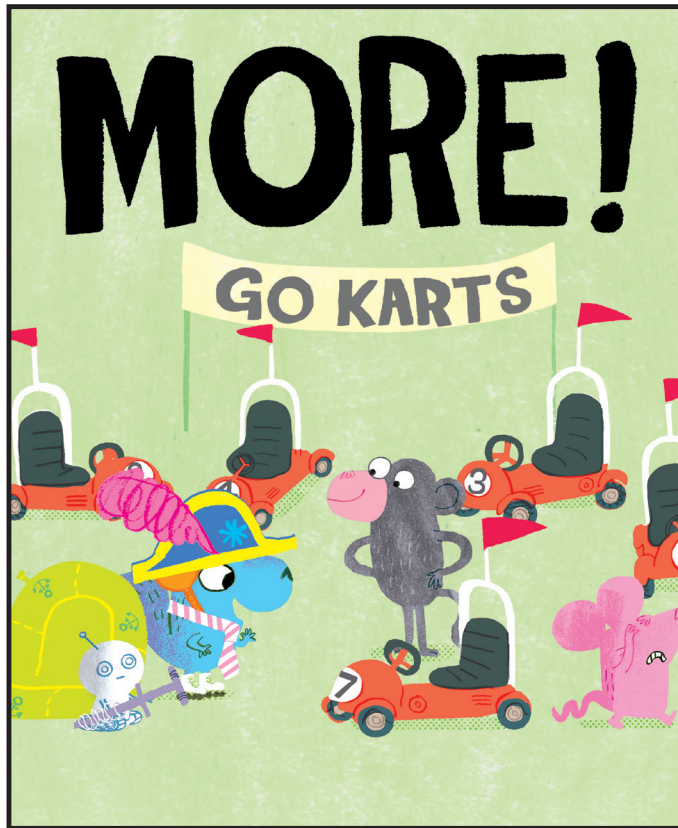
